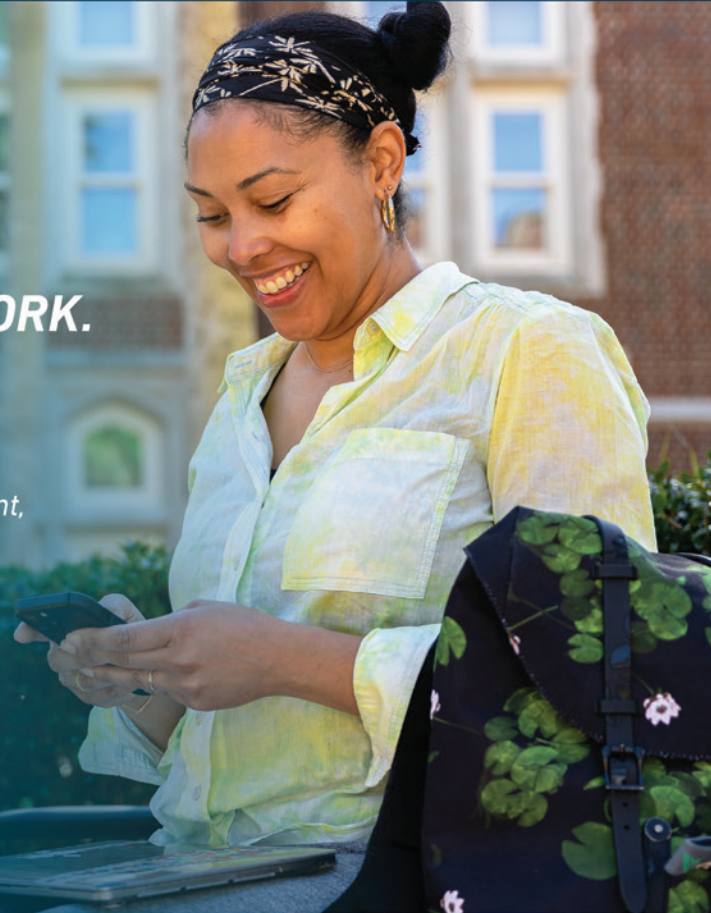

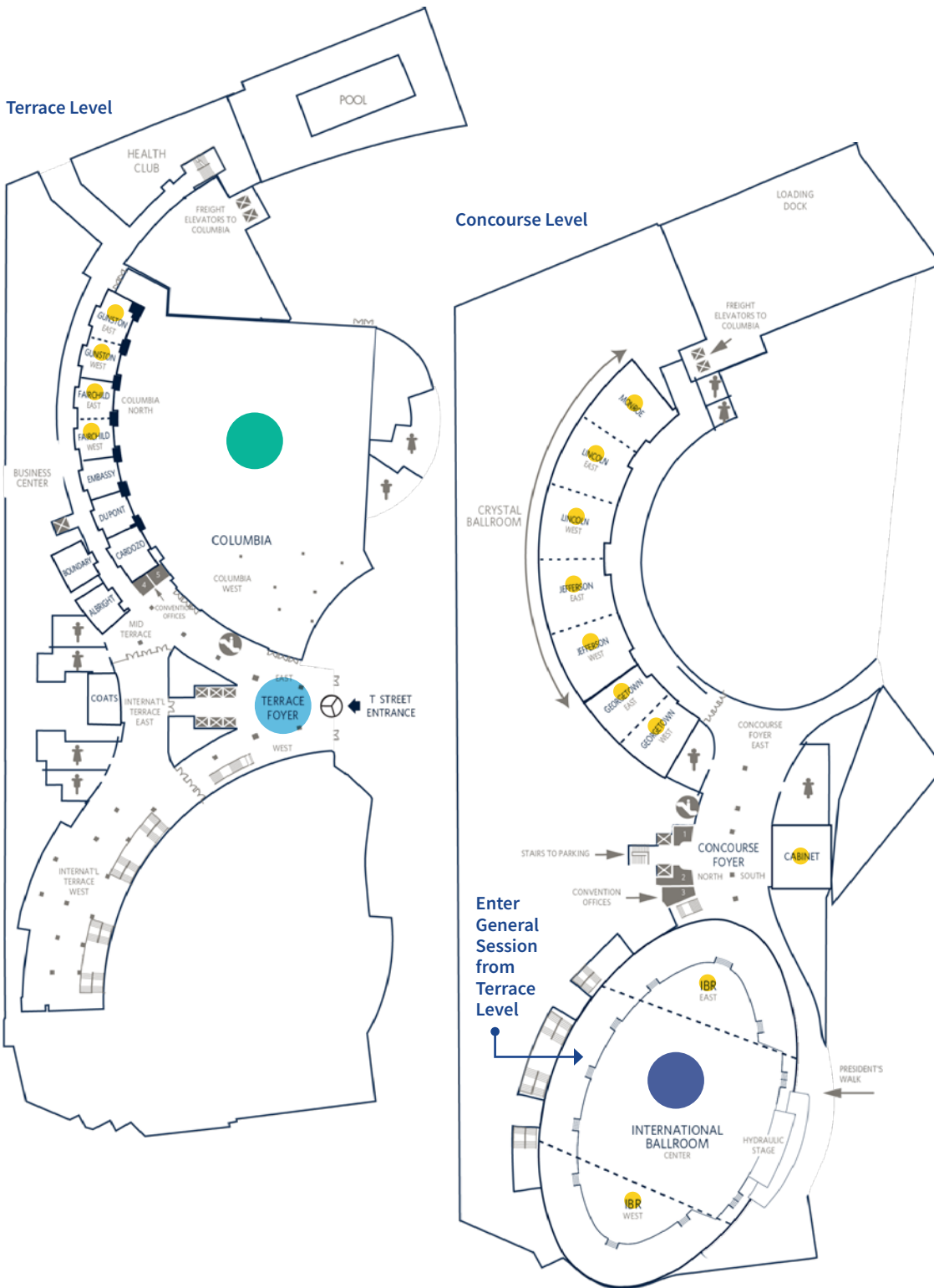

Sanjeev Arora, Founder of Project ECHO and the Executive Director of the ECHO Institute

Sanjeev Arora, MD, is the founder of Project ECHO and the Executive Director of the ECHO Institute. Dr. Arora is a Distinguished Professor of Medicine with tenure in the Department of Internal Medicine at the University of New Mexico Health Sciences Center. Dr. Arora is a pioneer in democratizing specialized medical knowledge for the good of humanity. His idea for Project ECHO was grounded in his personal experience as a liver disease specialist practicing in New Mexico whose patients endured an eight-month wait list for appointments and often drove hundreds of miles per visit. Delayed access to care adversely affected patient outcomes, resulting in unnecessary deaths from curable diseases like hepatitis C (HCV). Patients from New Mexico's geographically isolated communities suffered transportation, financial, and caregiver burdens, in addition to their health crises.
